The Performance confirmation report will show which of the two shows your child is in.

About The Performance: The Performance is a showcase of all the dancers at LDA. We celebrate their hard work in two shows.

The *SPRING CONCERT*: will be held on *Saturday, May 4th, 2024* at SUNY Purchase.
The Performances will be at 12:00 and 3:30

The *CABARET*: will be held on *Sunday, April 28th, 2024* at Fox Lane High school in Bedford.
The Performances will be at 12:00 and 3:30

PERFORMANCE LOCATION: **CONCERT:** SUNY Purchase **CABARET:** Fox Lane School in Bedford.
Both facilities offer comfortable seating, handicap access, air conditioning, and convenient parking.

COMMITMENT TO PERFORMANCE: A completed Performance Commitment Form is needed promptly so that the instructors will know how many students are being choreographed into each piece. If your dancer is not performing, a complete Commitment Form is still needed. *It is vital that our Instructors have confirmation of whether they are performing or not asap.*

- Deadline for commitment is February 18th, 2024 Payment due by March 31, 2024 If commitment and payment is not received by these date, we cannot guarantee that student will be allowed to perform.
Note: If your account is not up-to-date, participation fees and ticket purchases will not be accepted.

CONCERT PERFORMANCE COST:

- Participation Fee: The Participation Fee covers our additional insurance cost, rehearsal time, professional stage help and all professional video/ photography. Each performance Concert & Cabaret is assessed separately.
- Costume Rental Fee: Costume Fee covers fittings, alterations, repairs and cleaning (Per Class)
 - **STANDARD** Price (Cost if payment are received by March 31)
Participation Fee..... \$75.000 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$75.00 (Per Class)
 - **RUSH** Price (Cost if payment are received after March 31)
Participation Fee \$90.00 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$90.00 (Per Class)

CABARET PERFORMANCE COST:

- Participation Fee: The Participation Fee covers our additional insurance cost, rehearsal time, professional stage help, and all professional video/ photography. Each performance Concert & Cabaret is assessed separately.
- Costume Rental Fee: Costume Fee covers fittings, alterations, repairs and cleaning.
 - **STANDARD** Price (Cost if payment are received by March 31)
Participation Fee..... \$75.000 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$75.00 (Per Class)
 - **RUSH** Price (Cost if payment are received after March 31)
Participation Fee \$90.00 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$90.00 (Per Class)

ATTENDANCE – Pieces are being prepared for the Performance. Rehearsals will be scheduled and on our website. Your child’s perfect attendance from now until the performance is necessary. Rehearsals at the theater are mandatory. If your child misses these your child will NOT be able to participate.

COSTUMES: - Costumes for Concert will be fitted on specific date to be announced. Cabaret costumes will be fitted in class. All costumes are supplied on a rental basis and will be in the students’ dressing rooms on dress rehearsal and performance days.

- Costumes may not be taken out of the dressing rooms and should be returned to the room supervisor before you leave.
- A charge will be enforced if damaged costumes are returned.

Dancers should come with hair and make-up done.

- Parents are not allowed backstage. An LDA Assistant will bring your child from the foyer to the backstage area.
- If your child is in more than one number, there will be LDA staff available to provide assistance.

12:00pm All Dancers in Act II and 42nd St - Arrive by 10am ; All Others - Arrive by 11am

3:30pm All Dancers in Act II and 42nd St - Should stay in between shows ; All Others - Arrive by 2:30pm

- Dancers should come with hair and make-up done
- Parents are not allowed backstage. A LDA Assistant will bring your child from the foyer to the backstage area.
 - If your child is in more than one number there will be LDA staff available to provide assistance.

GETTING READY BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE: Done At Home

Hair & Makeup CONCERT & CABARET: Hair should be pulled back from face in a bun - No Bangs! Please use mousse and hairspray to keep hair neat and make certain that hair is secure and will last through the performance. Makeup - Light makeup including - Base, blush, mascara, and light lipstick. Jewelry - rings, necklaces, bracelets & watches are not allowed. No **Small stud** earrings unless directors approve. NO nail polish

- Dancers MUST Supply:
 - All Makeup
 - Tights - clean and run-free
 - Shoes - Clean with elastic sewn on
- Label ALL your dancers belongings. LDA and the venue will not be responsible for lost items. Even with names on items we will not guarantee a return of lost items.
- **DURING THE PERFORMANCE:** Costumes may NOT be taken out of the dressing rooms and should be returned to the room supervisor before your dancer leaves.

ENJOY THE PERFORMANCE: We want you to relax and enjoy the show

- Dancers will wait to be escorted to their dressing rooms by assistants. Dancers should not leave the building without parental supervision.
- Parents are NOT allowed backstage at any time during the performance unless they are working in an official capacity.
- This is a Family Event with most of the staff made up of volunteers and polite behavior is expected. Arguing with other patrons, staff, police, etc. or swearing will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the premises.
- Please be kind and put trash in the designated containers.

- Supervision - Please make sure that your dancer arrives at the time indicated on the chart for all rehearsal and for the performance.
- Please leave your dancers clothing with them backstage so that they can be dressed in their street clothing after they've finished their performance and will be ready for pick up. Please pick up your dancer at the scheduled times.
- No dancer is allowed in the audience in the performance costume or dance class attire.
- To ensure that your dancer can join you for the rest of the performance, you must purchase a ticket and pick up your dancer at Intermission, then personally escort your dancer in the auditorium after they are out of costume and makeup.
- Videotaping of rehearsals and performances is NOT allowed.
- A professional photographer will be at the performance - a link will be provided after the performance on our website for parents to download.

NEW Dancer Families: Please know that we expect parents to be in the audience for the entire act. Our performances are professional theatrical performances. For your enjoyment and the enjoyment of the entire audience please remain seated, but if you must leave, please do so **ONLY** between acts and return **ONLY** between acts.
